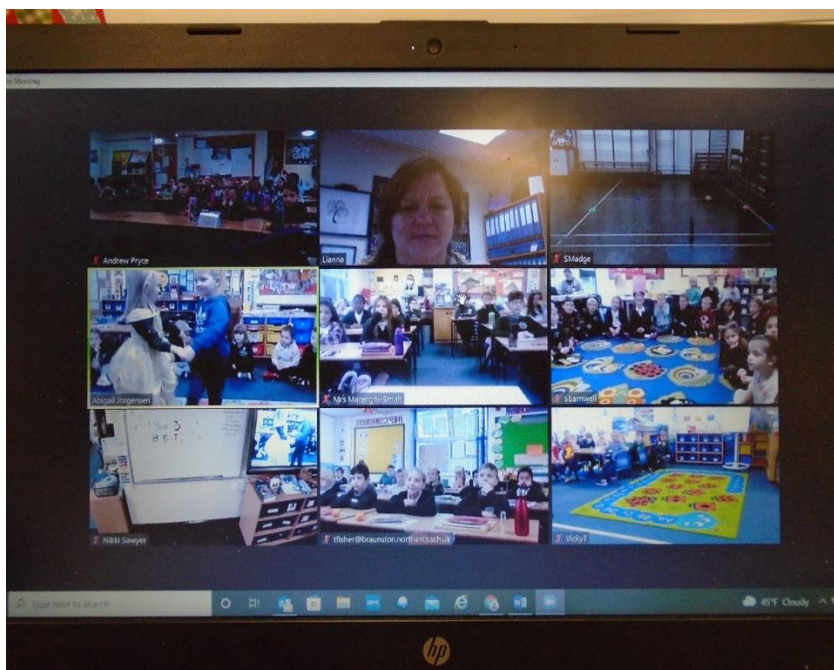

Year 3 paid a visit to Church this week for Christingle and Hope was chosen for The Lunchtime Champion for this term.



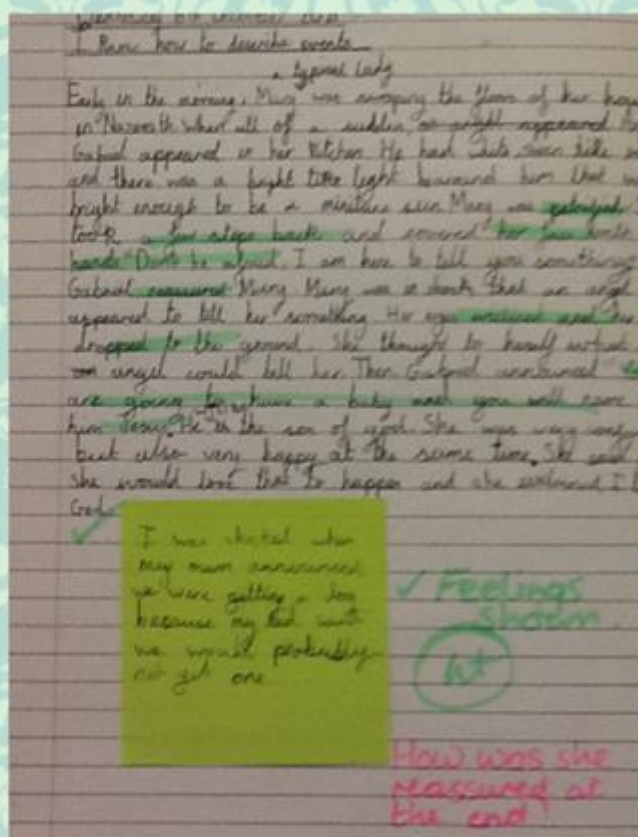


Earlier in the week Year 4 welcomed parents into school to look at their children's books and listen to Christmas songs.
